In consideration of being permitted to participate in any way the **Stoccata School of Defence inc.** ("Stoccata") or any Stoccata-sponsored Activities ("Activity") I, for myself, my personal representatives, assigns, heirs and next of kin:

1) Acknowledge, agree and represent that I understand the nature of Martial Arts, Swordsmanship, Fencing and Weapons Training activities and that I am qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such activity. I agree and warrant that if at any time I believe conditions to be unsafe, I will immediately discontinue further participation in the Activity. I also acknowledge that the Activity may be conducted in facilities open to the public during the Activity.

2) Fully understand that:

- a) Martial Arts, Swordsmanship, Fencing and Weapons Training activities involve risks and dangers of serious bodily harm, injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death ("Risks")
- b) these Risks and dangers include the use of training weapons which may strike the head, face, or any other part of the body during bouts or any other kind of practice
- c) these Risks and dangers may be caused by my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the Activity, the condition in which the Activity takes place, or the negligence of the "Releasees" named below.
- d) there may be other Risks and social and economic losses either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I fully accept and assume all such Risks and all responsibility for losses, costs and damages I incur as a result of my participation in the Activity.

3) Hereby release, discharge, and covenant not to sue Stoccata, their respective administrators, directors, agents, officers, members, volunteers and employees, other participants, any sponsors, advertisers, and owners and lessors of premises on which the Activity takes place (each considered one of the "Releasees" herein) from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages on my account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the "Releasees" or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations: and I further agree that if, despite this Release and waiver of liability, assumption of risk, and indemnity agreement I, or anyone acting on my behalf, make a claim against any of the Releasees, I will indemnify, save, hold harmless each of the Releasees from any litigation expenses, fees, loss, liability, damage or cost which any may incur as the result of such claim.
